Hotel Information

1. A group of rooms have been blocked off for us at the [Wingate Inn in Lynchburg](#). Our special group rate is \$99 plus tax per night. To get this rate, please call the hotel directly to make your reservations, and let them know that you are part of the Reformed Episcopal group. The number is (434) 845-1700, or toll free at 888-494-6428.
2. The rate includes a continental breakfast every morning. This is an especially good deal for those who have up to 4 in each room, as that means that up to four of you get a free breakfast for the same rate as one.
3. Most attendees will probably want to check in Wednesday, 23 September, and check out Saturday, 26 September. If any of you intend to come to Lynchburg early, stay later, or need to leave early, that is not a problem. It may be a good idea to make your reservations early if you fit into that category.
4. All the rooms can legally house up to four people. There are two kinds of rooms available: a) a king-sized bed with a sleeper sofa (which is the equivalent of a full-sized bed); and b) two queen-sized beds. If your party consists of only one person, please request one of the king-bed rooms, so that the larger parties can have the queen-bed rooms.

5. The hotel sits on the edge of Chandler's Mountain and offers a very nice view of Lynchburg and the Blue Ridge Mountains. If you want a mountain-side view, make sure you ask for it.

6. The deadline for making these reservations at this rate is Friday, August 21.
